

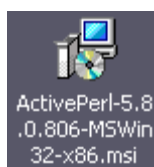
Setting up Active Perl

First you will need to download the latest setup file. This can be obtained from

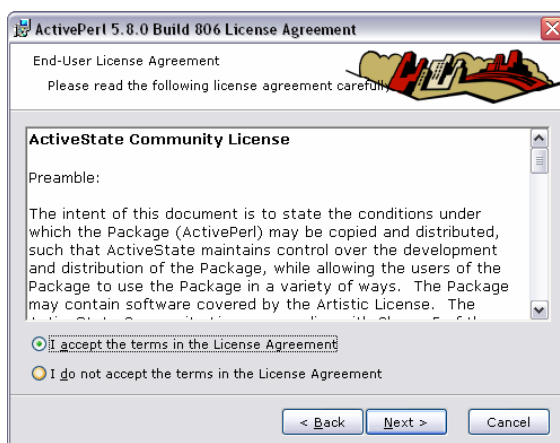

I will be using version 5.8.0.

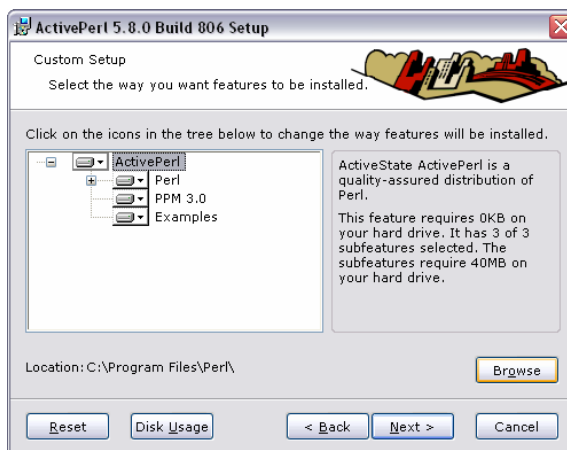
Once you have downloaded the MSI setup file double click it to open it.



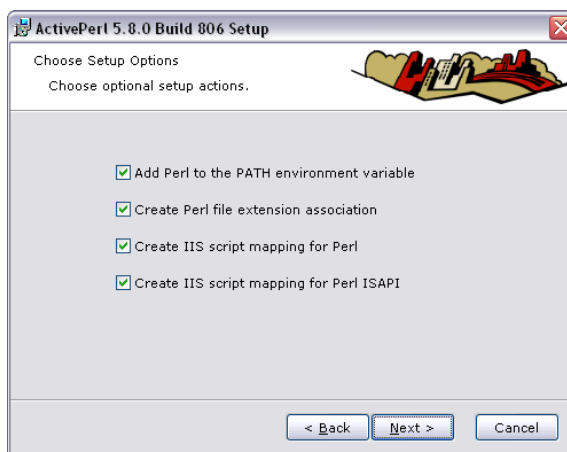
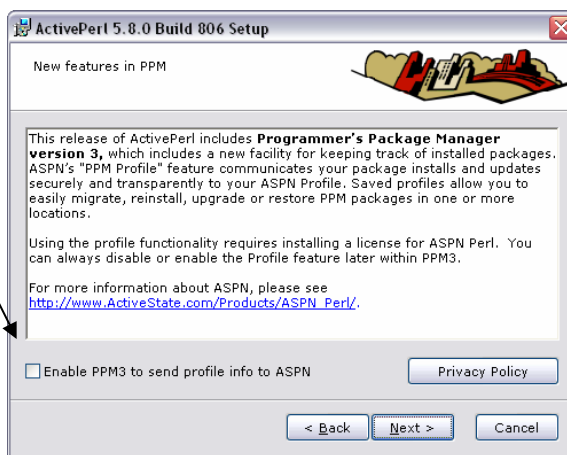
On the right are all of the setup screens you will see from the wizard.



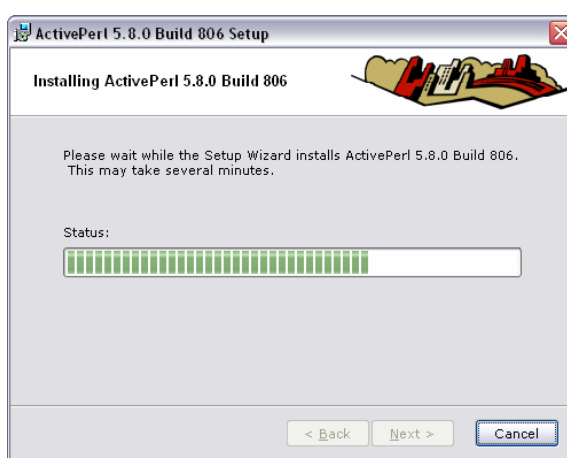
Here you can change the environment path to a location of your choice by clicking on browse. Here I have changed it from the default "C:\Perl" to "C:\Program Files\Perl".



If you wish to send details to the perl creators then you will need to check this box



Once you click “install” the installation will begin



To complete the setup click finish. You can also choose whether or not you want to display the release notes
