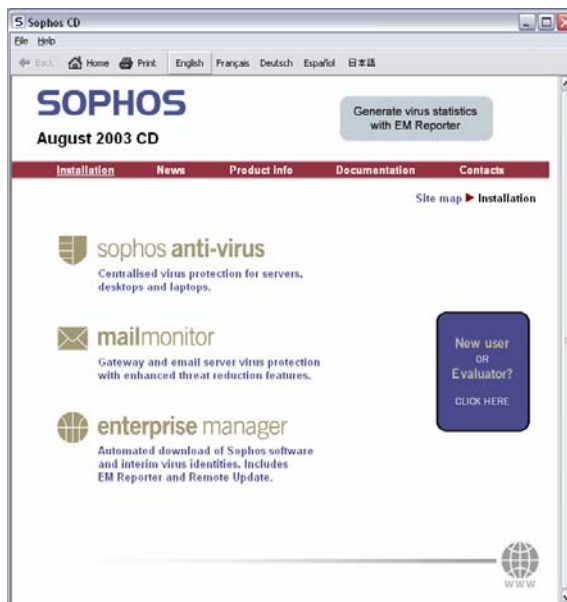
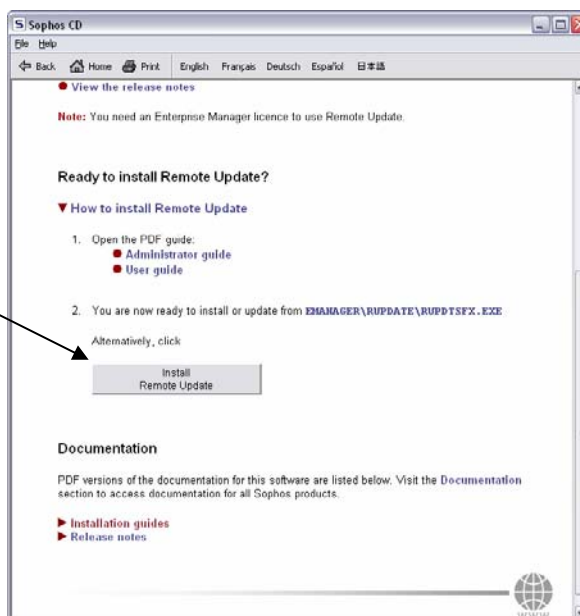


Sophos Remote Update

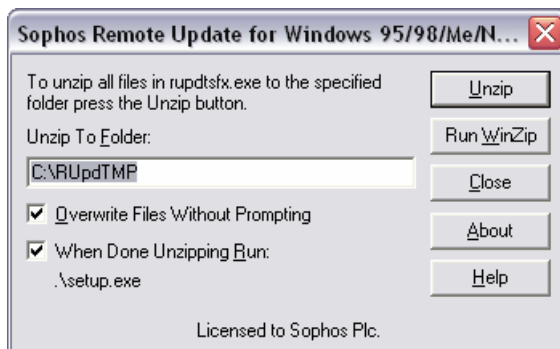
Enter the Sophos CD into the computer and the following screen should open.



Click on “Enterprise Manager” and then select “Remote Update”. Scroll down and click on “how to Install Remote Update”. Click the “Install Remote Update” button.

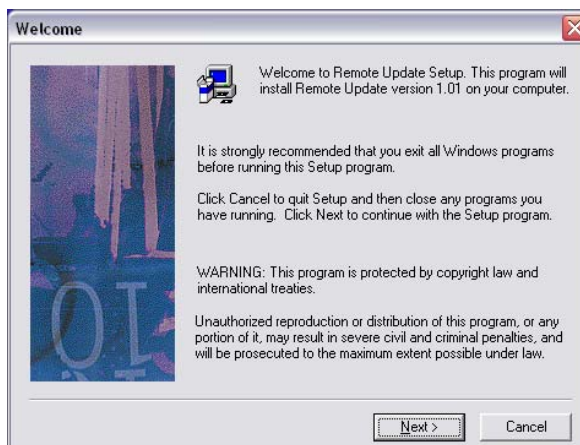


Remote update will now extract it's self. Click "OK" then click "Unzip" (leaving the default options)



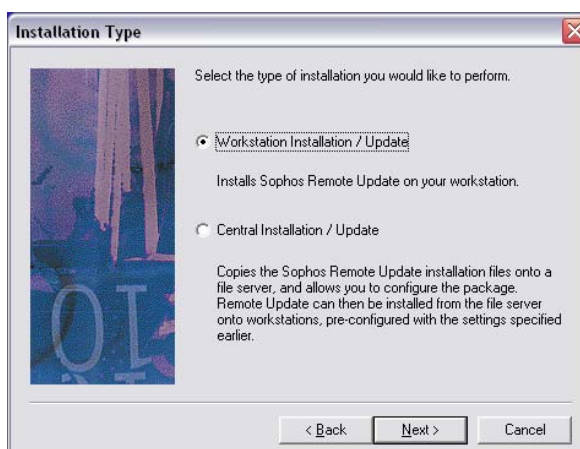
Once Remote update has unzipped it will automatically launch the setup procedure.

In the initial box click "Next"



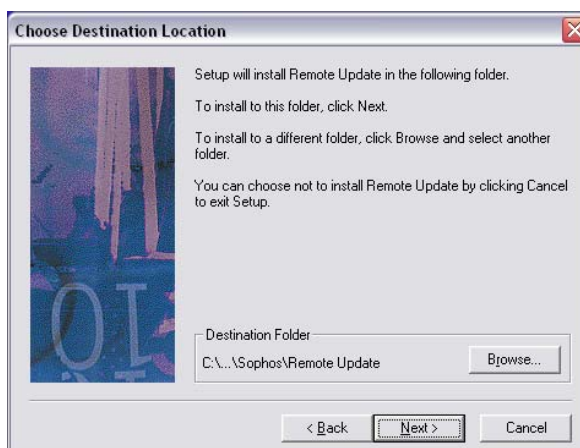
Keep the default option for the installation type. A "Workstation Installation / Update"

Click "Next"



Choose a location to install Remote update to. I suggest you leave the default location.

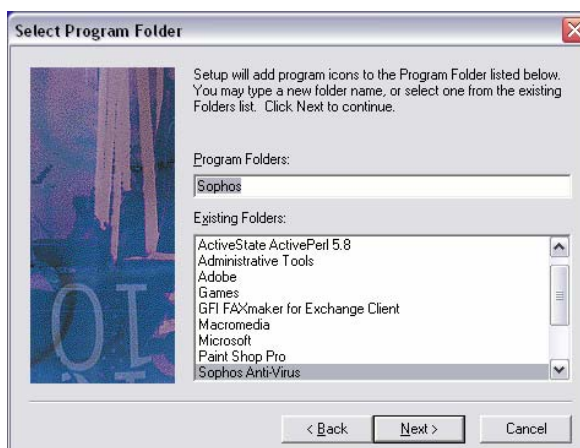
Click “Next”



The next screen is to choose a name for the start menu listing; leave this as default

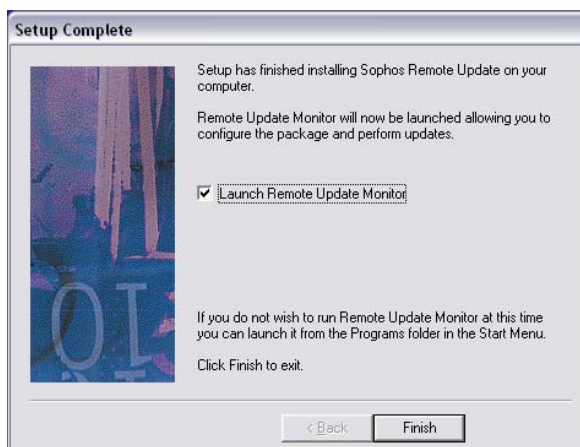
Click “Next” and then “Next” again.

Remote update should then install.

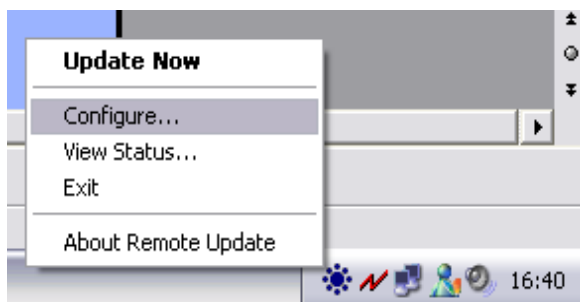


When this screen appears click on “Finish”

When you do a message box telling you to configure “Remote Update” will appear. Click “OK”



Once complete an icon will appear in the bottom right hand corner of the screen. Right click this and select “Configure...”



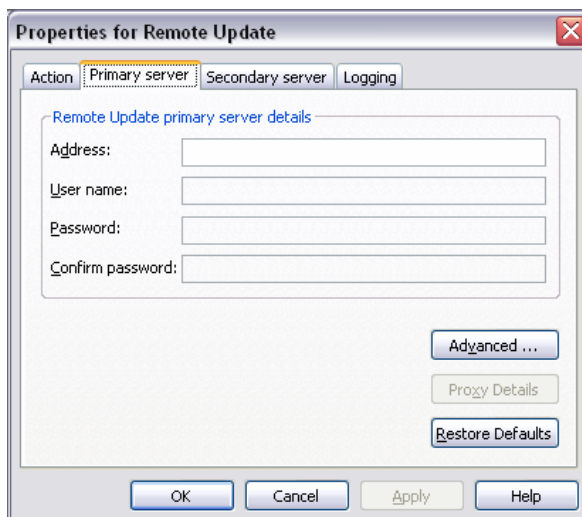
When the popup box appears click the “Primary Server” tab

In the Address box type in: “mailgate.plustech.co.uk”

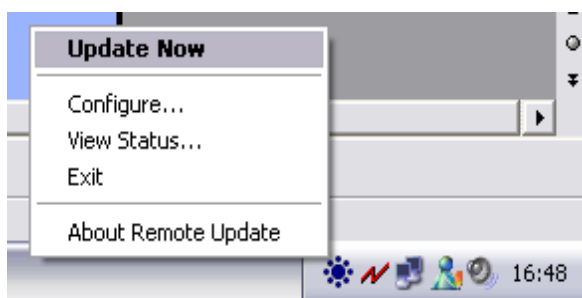
Enter your allocated “username and “Password” in the relevant boxes.

If your company is running a Proxy server ensure the correct details are entered in the “Proxy Details”.

Finally click “OK”



In order to update your system right click on the remote update icon and select update now.



Two update boxes will appear once these have downloaded the latest updates then your computer will be updated against the latest virus protection.
